WEB SITE MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

1. Interpretations

1.1 Unless the context otherwise admits words importing one gender shall include all other genders and words importing the singular shall include the plural and vice versa.

1.2 Reference to any statutory provisions in this Agreement shall include any statutory provisions, which amends or replaces it.

2. Outline of Agreement

2.1 This Agreement details the terms and conditions agreed between the Parties for the maintenance, (including technical and design maintenance) hereinafter known as "Website Maintenance" for the Client of the following website *[Insert website address]*, such work to be undertaken by the Contractor.

2.2 This Website Maintenance Agreement shall run for an Initial Term as defined in Schedule One of this Agreement.

3. Website Maintenance Specification

3.1 The Parties have agreed the detailed Website Maintenance specification as defined in Schedule One of this Agreement.

3.2 Any amendments proposed to this Website Maintenance specification must be made in writing and delivered to the other party. Either party is entitled to request a meeting to discuss such amendments.

3.3 If such proposed amendments incur additional expense the Contractor is entitled to seek further payment to cover such expense.

4. Maintenance Fees

4.1 The Client will pay the agreed Maintenance Fees to the Contractor as detailed in Schedule One at the agreed intervals. The Contractor will invoice the Client and the Client will pay the invoice, including Value Added Tax, (VAT) at the prevailing rate according to the terms of payment detailed on the invoice.

4.2 The Contractor will require regular and timely payment where the Website Maintenance involves ongoing work over a considerable period of time. Such payments will be made in accordance with the Maintenance Charges as defined in Schedule One of this Agreement, or if not specified in Schedule One to be agreed in writing by the parties prior to the commencement of the Website Maintenance.

4.3 All payments to the Contractor shall be paid within 30 days after the receipt of the Contractor's invoice for such payment.

4.4 The Contractor shall be entitled to renegotiate the ongoing Maintenance Fees prior to the expiry of the Initial Term of this Agreement in order to allow for any increase in the Fees after the expiry of the Initial Term.

4.5 The Contractor will give the Client at least 60 days notice prior to the expiry of the Initial Term of his intention to renegotiate the Fees. The Contractor will provide full details to the Client at the time of the notice.

5. Expenses

5.1 The Client will pay the expenses incurred by the Contractor during the Website Maintenance, including travel to the offices of the Client where required, the purchase of computer consumables required for the Website Maintenance and such other reasonable expenses directly related to the Website Maintenance.

5.2 The Contractor will inform the Client in writing in advance if significant expenses not covered by clause 5.1 has to be incurred during the Website Maintenance.

6. Delivery

6.1 The Contractor will deliver the completed Website Maintenance to the Client by way of Compact Disc, (CD) or such other data storage method as selected by the Contractor.

6.2 If the Client requires the completed Website Maintenance to be loaded onto a fileserver using File Transfer Protocol (FTP) the Contractor is entitled to make an additional reasonable charge for this service. The Client is responsible for ensuring that the intended fileserver or disk space on the fileserver is properly configured. The Contractor will not load the completed Website Maintenance onto a publicly available fileserver or disk space on such a fileserver until the Client has complied with the conditions laid out in clause 7 below.
